The Australian Tutoring Association in partnership with Accredited Tutor has been engaged by the Victorian Government to deliver Child Safe Standards training to owners, operators and managers of tutoring organisations (and all organisations in the post-secondary / supplementary education sector).

All Victorian tutoring businesses, tutoring organisations and tutors will be required to comply with the new Child Safe Standards legislation by 1st January 2017.
